Below, you will find a brief overview of all of our programs and services that we operate.

Services to People with a Disability

Case Management Services

Each Individual with a Disability who Receives Services from Northwoods is Assigned to a Case Manager. Our Professional Case Management Staff Designs an Individualized Program for Each Person with a Disability in Order to Help Them Become & Remain as Independent as Possible in Their Work & the Community

Vocational Evaluation

We Use a Variety of Testing Techniques to Evaluate the Employability Potential of Adults with a Disability

Work Adjustment

Person with Disability is Employed up to 90 days in Our Own Work Settings to Help Eliminate Limitations to Competitive Employment.

Long Term Employment

Employed at Northwoods for Indefinite Period of Time to Learn and Practice Good Work Skills and Behaviors

Placement & Supported Employment

Our Staff Assists the Person with a Disability to Find and Keep a Job in a Competitive Setting

Day Services/Special Needs

Adults with Severe Disabilities Receive Training for Independence and provided Socialization and Vocational Training Services

Daily Living Skills Training

Training to Help Person with a Disability Become and Remain Independent in their Own Homes and in the Community.

Recreation/Leisure Training

Teach Adults with Disabilities How to Access Community Social & Recreational Opportunities.

Parent Aide Program

Direct Services to Families

Training, Counseling, and Intervention to Parents and Family members in order to keep the family together.

Representative Payee

We Help SSI Recipients manage their money and report to Social Security

Assistive Technology

Computers & Adaptive Equipment To Assist Persons with Disability

Our Work Evaluation & Work Training Sites

For Some, Our Work Training Sites Provide Long Term Employment. For Others, the Training is a Stepping Stone to Community Based Employment

Industrial Services

We Use Real Subcontract Work Procured from Local Industry to Teach Adults with Disabilities Good Work Skills. Packaging, Assembly, and Light Manufacturing.

Rest Area Maintenance Program

Under Contract with WISDOT, We Provide Year Round Maintenance of Buildings and Grounds at 2 Rest Areas on I-90/94 near Portage, 2 Rest Areas South of Fond du lac on Hwy 41, 2 Rest Areas North of Westfield on I-39 & 5 Seasonal Waysides in Adams Co. 75% of all direct labor is done by persons with disabilities

Computer Refurbishment

Donated computers are refurbished & sold at retail & on eBay. Some labor is provided by persons with disabilities.

Services to Seniors and Frail Adults

Supportive Home Care

Assist Seniors and Frail Adults to Stay Living in Their Own Homes Rather Than in Group Homes or Nursing Homes. Services Include Cooking, Cleaning, Running Errands, Shopping, Medical Transport, Snow Removal, and Lawn Care.

Chore Service

Minimal, Basic Service Designed to Assist Seniors to Stay Independent in Their Own Homes.
